WHAT'S SERVICE USER INVOLVEMENT ALL ABOUT?

Service User Involvement is when the people receiving a service are involved in the development and planning of it. On a personal level, this can be **getting involved** in choosing your treatment pathway, or on a more strategic level it can be giving your opinion to services and team managers to make **positive changes** to the service.

Basically, Service User Involvement means that service users have the opportunity to say what they feel is being done right, and what is being done wrong in the services in Slough. This means that providers and tiers of management can work together to change things for the better, and service users can feel (individually or as a group) that they're opinions are being **valued and appreciated**.
